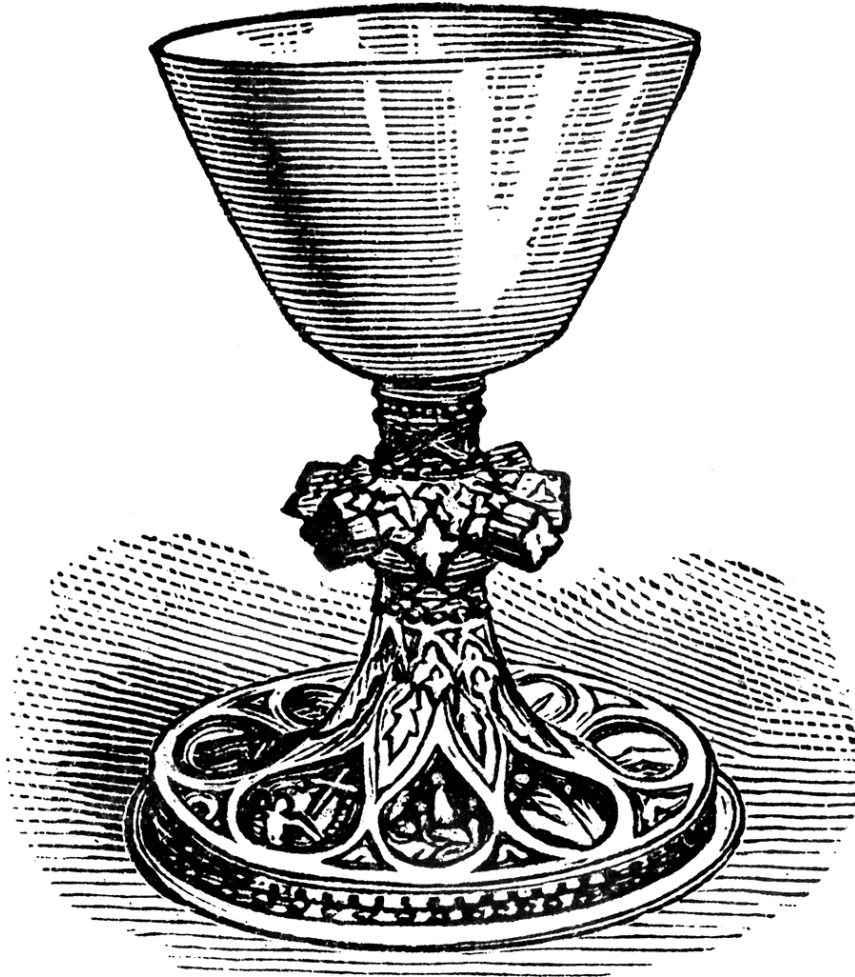

Andrew Loran Raines is a recent graduate of Duke University in Durham, North Carolina, where he studied history and Attic Greek. Andrew grew up in the country on Cypress Branch of Lynches River near Olanta, South Carolina. There, his family still farms various crops, including hay, tobacco, and Longleaf pine trees. In this context, he was raised on the Southern arts of story-telling and (vinegar) barbecue. His grandmother, a librarian, taught him how to read with *The Hundred and One Dalmatians* and the King James Bible. He loves to sing (most recently in Duke's Chapel Choir and its co-ed Christian a cappella group SBSB) and play organ and piano (at one point viola). He has a severe book-buying addiction and is willing to speak at length with you about authors like Flannery O'Connor, Eugene Vodolazkin, or John Behr (or anything, really—Southern people like to talk).
