

The food parcels are given free and without question, but if you wish to make a donation this is most welcome and will be used to buy supplies.

The Food Stall will run until the end of the year. It is run in conjunction with Colville Councillors at All Saints Church. Please remember the Food Stall is available to all, including those who worship with us.

All food is distributed under the strictest hygiene safety, and safeguarding practice. Due to demand we are able to give 8 items per person.

No food is stored on site.

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION AND CONFIRMATION

These will take place on Sunday 29th November, Advent Sunday, at 11am at All Saints when we will be joined by the Bishop of Fulham. Please join us for this important celebration.

BAPTISMS

Under the new Covid-19 Guidelines Baptisms are allowed. However if they take place outside the main Sunday Mass the attendance is limited to 6 people. The number of people who can attend Weddings has been reduced to 15 but remains at 30 for funerals in church.
